The Beaverton Fair attracts approximately 4,500 adults (over age 14) and 1,000 children in total over the three days.

The Commercial Exhibitors fee for

- Indoor space is \$125.00 (10' x 10' space)
- Outdoor space is \$100.00 (10' x20' space)
- Farmer's Market is \$25.00/ day (restricted to produce)

COMMUNITY SERVICE CLUBS receive a free space based on availability. The space is to be used to increase community awareness and fund-raise. If the Service Club is selling an item for profit there will be a 10% fee. Although the space is free, fair passes must be paid for at a reduced rate.

AGRICULTURAL GROUPS receive a free space as the Society objective is to increase an awareness and appreciation of agriculture and the rural lifestyle. Although the space is free, fair passes must be paid for at a reduced rate.

Items to be noted

- Indoor space is limited- floor plan is included for Arena and may change as schedule is finalized
- Indoor space is issued on a **first come first serve** basis with preference to long time vendors
- Outdoor space -vehicle & trailer parking will be included in the space allotted at the discretion of the Society. Please indicate on contract if you wish to park a trailer on your space.
- INDICATE PREFERENCE in order of an outdoor or indoor booth
- Community Service groups depending on availability will generally be outside
- Agricultural Groups please indicate if your booth will be manned or information pamphlets

The Rules and Regulations are attached. Please read in detail before signing the contract. Complete all areas of the attached contract. Please specify if you are selling raffle tickets and lottery licence number. **Return contract with full payment** to the address above by **August 31** to reserve your space.
