

The 2024 Beaverton Fall Fair Junior Ambassador Competition

Thursday, May 30th at 7:00pm at the Beaverton Town Hall

Rules and Regulations

**Registrations will be accepted beginning March 28th, 2024.
Contestants must be registered by April 30th, 2024.**

1. The junior competition is open to any male or female ages 12-16 as of January 1st, 2024. All competitors must reside within the boundaries of Brock Township or attend a school in Brock Township.
2. Each contestant is required to have a \$100.00 business or organization sponsorship. The sponsorship includes the business name on a sash and special recognition throughout the competition. If possible, we would encourage the sponsors to come to the competition in support of their participant. Cheques should be made payable to the Beaverton Agricultural Society.
3. The judges will interview each contestant during the evening on Tuesday, May 28th 2024. All competitors will be required to make an **All About Me Board**. More information will be provided closer to the date.
4. Junior contestants will be required to give a 2-3 minute speech during the Junior Ambassador competition on May 30th, at 7:00pm. Topics will be announced closer to the date. The contestants will also be given an impromptu question.
5. All contestants are asked to represent their sponsors and attend both Fair Days (Friday Sept. 13, 2024 and Saturday Sept. 14th, 2024).
6. The placing contestants must fulfill obligations outlined by the committee. Examples include attending, participating, or assisting in three community events throughout the year. Options to be determined, however they may include the Beaverton Santa Claus Parade, Canada Day festivities, and assisting at the Legion Public Speaking competition.
7. Contestants applying for a second time, for a competition they have already competed in, will not be accepted until after April 30th, to provide

the opportunity to everyone. Winning ambassadors and runners up may not compete for a consecutive year.

8. A participant will be disqualified if their conduct is found to contradict any of the Ambassador Program rules and regulations, or if they fail to observe any instructions set out by the committee. The Ambassadors represent the Beaverton Agricultural Society and their behaviour must be acceptable at all times.

9. The winners will receive a package upon being rewarded that will outline in more detail their new role as a Junior Ambassador.
